

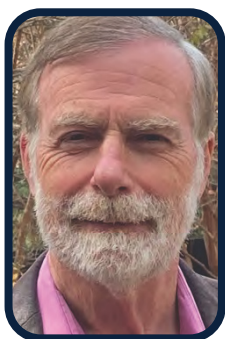
How to effectively identify and call out address Broader Impacts in the NSF CAREER

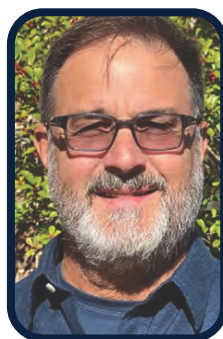
