

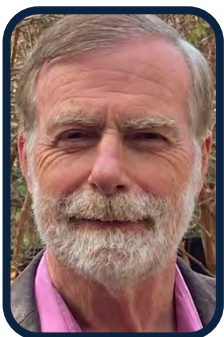
NAVIGATING THE NSF CAREER AWARD
